WHEREAS, all users must be on the bank signature card, therefore be it

RESOLVED, by Travis Moothart Post No. 184, The American Legion, Department of Oregon, in regular meeting assembled in Brownsville, Oregon, September 12<sup>th</sup>, 2017, That ARTICLE VI – FINANCES AND DUES Section 4. be amended to read All Post monies shall be deposited in a duly authorized banking institution as designated by the Post Executive Committee, and none of such monies shall be withdrawn except upon draft, ~~or~~ check, ~~or~~ debit card. Draft or Check will be signed by the Post Finance Officer and countersigned by ~~the Post Commander or Adjutant~~ a designated officer who is on the bank signature card. Debit card will be used by the Finance Officer or designated representative and approved by the Post Commander.
